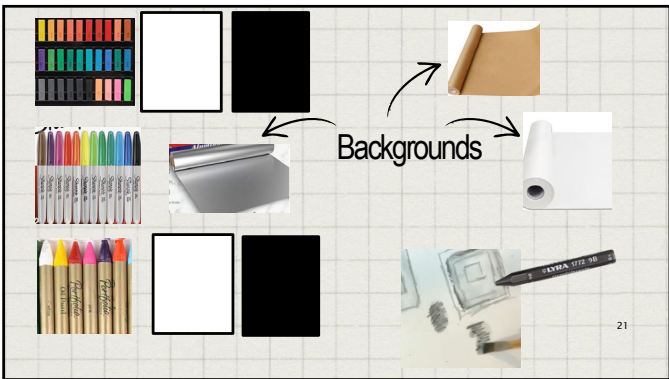
THE 4 CORE PROCESS ART ACTIVITIES

- Painting more than painting projects to finish them (or even the easel)

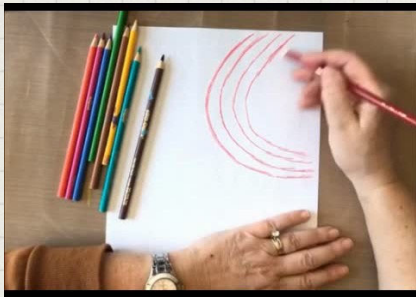

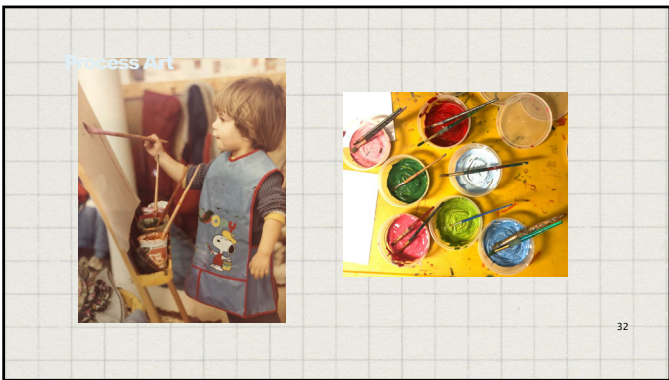
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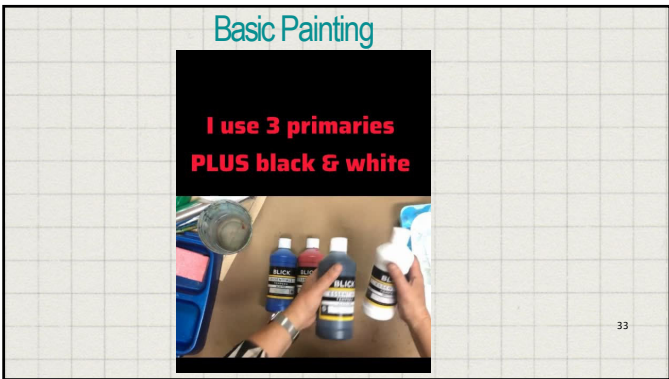


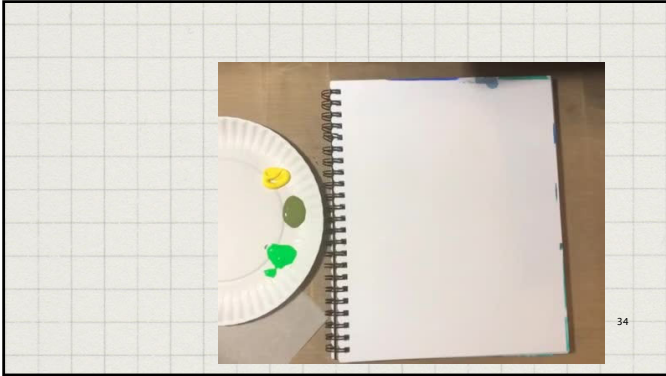












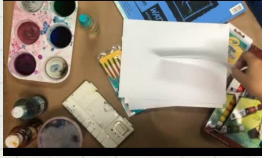
Motivations for Kids who say "I don't know what to make"

- Make a bunch of outlines in one color and fill them in with a different color.
- Fill a page by painting shapes next to each other leaving one empty white space on the paper.
- Make two blobs and 3 outline shapes.
- Make a blob shape inside an outline.
- Do lots of blobs connected to each other
- Paint larger shapes and then when it's a bit dry, paint a smaller one of the same type on top of it or paint a different shape on top of it.
- Fill a page with organic shapes.
- Fill a page with geometric shapes.



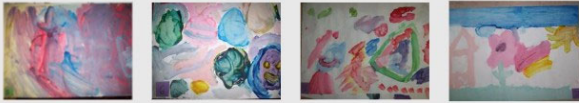
