



Cooperative Children's Book
Center 2012 Survey

The Cooperative Children's Book Center 2012 Survey of 3,600 children's books published in 2012, found a lack of racial diversity in children's books.

What % of those books do you think included people of color?



What % of the 3,600 children's books surveyed by CCBC in 2012 included people of color?

- 75% 100%
- 50% 75%
- 25% 50%
- 5% 25%
- Less than 5%





  - •Contain "good" characters, including ones in leadership roles, from variety of backgrounds
